The knob of the bat should be lined up with the crease between your wrist and your hand. If the knob is level with your palm, you probably need a longer bat. If the knob is at your forearm, find a shorter bat. Buying a discount softball bat does not mean you should have to sacrifice your comfort, performance or your chance for improvement.

Once you have found a bat with suitable length, get a feel for the weight. It should feel as if it's the heaviest bat you can manage without losing swing speed or mechanics, or knocking yourself out. Even a few ounces can mean the difference between a suitable bat, and the best bat for you.
